SUBJECT:

Adoption of a policy and procedure regarding use of marijuana (including

medical marijuana) on any property owned by the Association.

PURPOSE:

To provide notice of the Association's marijuana policy.

AUTHORITY: The Declarations of Covenants, Articles, Bylaws of the Association and the

Colorado Revised Statues.

EFFFECTIVE

RESOLUTION: The Association hereby gives notice of its adoption of the following policies and procedures regarding use of marijuana:

- 1. Use of marijuana (including medical marijuana) is prohibited on any property owned by the Association.
- 2. Homeowners will be responsible for their guests who violate this regulation and will be held accountable for any penalties.
- 3. Penalties
 - a. Each violator will be fined \$100 per offense, to include each guest in violation.
 - b. Homeowner's key(s) will be revoked for 90 days along with privileges to use of the clubhouse, pool, barn, and arena.
- 4. Definitions. Unless otherwise defined in this Resolution, initially capitalized or terms defined in the Declaration shall have the same meaning herein.
- 5. Supplement to Law. The provisions of the Resolution shall be in addition to and in supplement of the terms and provisions of the Declaration and the law of the state of Colorado governing the Project.
- 6. <u>Deviations</u>. The Board may deviate from the procedures set forth in this Resolution if in its sole discretion such deviation is reasonable under the circumstances.
- 7. Amendment. This policy may be amended by the Board of Directors at their discretion.
